- Binocular with range finder
- Rifles
- Scope covers
- Boots with thick soles
- Ammo
- Passport, visas and Health certificate
- U.S. Customs declaration form 4457 for rifles
- Cell phone/camera and battery charger cords
- Electrical outlet converters
- Shorts - Two pair
- Long Pants - Three pair
- Three long sleeve shirts
- Socks - Three pair
- Underwear (optional)
- Belt for pants
- Hunting Coat - appropriate for evening temperatures
- Camp shoes
- Toiletry items
- Rain gear - Light-weight (no matter if it hasn't rained there for five years, pack a set anyway...)
- Day backpack
- Hat - Baseball type or if you are sensitive to the sun a bigger one that gives you more protection.
- Ziploc gallon and quart size freezer bags - 6
- Hunting belt with ammo pouch and knife
- Light-weight leather gloves
- Bandanas - 3 mosquito repellent imbedded ones
- Sunglasses
- Clear lens safety glasses- for riding in the back of the hunting truck in the dark
- Malaria Prophylaxis
- Insect bite relief cream
- Journal and extra pens
- Small gun cleaning kit
- Satellite phone
- Small Medical Kit
- Toilet paper and sanitary wipes
- Hand sanitizer - small bottle
- Lens cleaners
- Ear plugs
- Paperback books
- Duct tape $\frac{1}{2}$ roll
- Electrical tape $\frac{1}{2}$ roll
- Name tags with your info on one side and your taxidermist's info on the other. Include your broker's name as well. Enough zip ties to secure tags for all skulls and skins of trophies you may collect
- Headlamp - extra batteries
- Sun protection lotions
